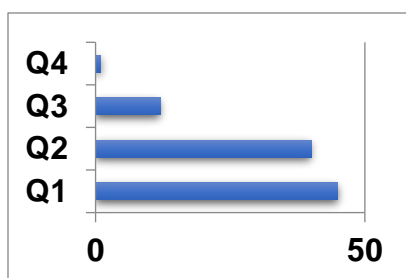


Pharmacognosy Department Achievements (Second Semester 2023/2024)
