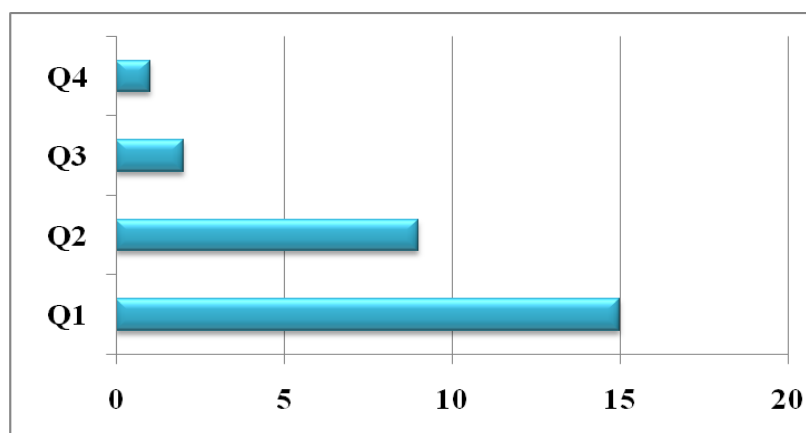


Pharmacognosy Department Achievements (Second Semester 2022/2023)

1- Scientific Research

- The department achieves a leading position for research in the field of natural products by conducting quality research at international level, and motivating staff members to strive for excellence.
- The Staff members have published 27 international publications from January to April 2023 in journals with high impact factor ranging from 0.4 to 11.18 and one published book chapter.



- Professor/ Abdel Nasser Singab – Professor of Pharmacognosy – Faculty of Pharmacy- Ain Shams University- Chairman of Center of Drug Discovery Research and Development – Former Vice President of Postgraduates and Research Affairs, was among the top 2% Stanford University Scientists of the most influential scientists in the scientific career in the world for the third year in a row.
- Professor/ Mohamed Lotfy Ashour – Professor of Pharmacognosy - Faculty of Pharmacy- Ain Shams University and Associate Professor/ Fadia Salah Youssef - Associate Professor of Pharmacognosy - were among the top 2% Stanford university scientists.

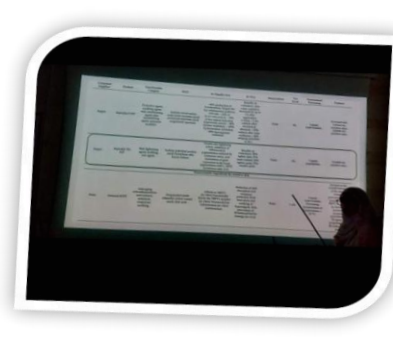
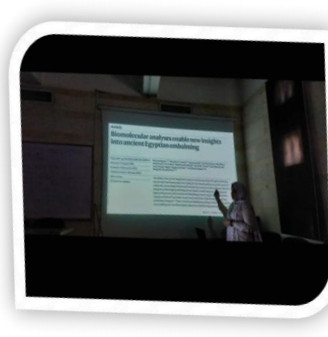
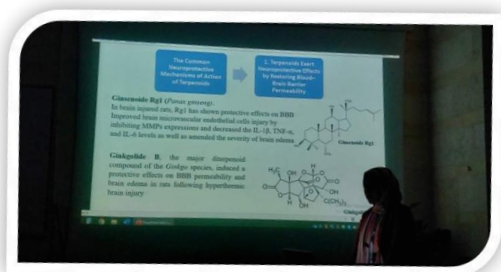
